 Sub :- Introduction of Machine Scrutiny of Bail Applications from 10.07.2023- guidelines -reg
Ref :- High Court notice of even number dated 06.07.2023

The High Court, with an aim to enhance efficacy and expediency in the e-filing and to reduce human efforts in the process, has introduced Machine Scrutiny (Auto Scrutiny) of Bail Applications from 10.07.2023, vide notice cited.

Now, in continuation of the said notice, following guidelines are issued for information and compliance :-

1) To use this module, 'quick e-filing' method is to be followed. The efiler has to select one of the options given below: Auto scrutiny/Machine scrutiny or Scrutiny by the Filing Scrutiny Officer (FSO).

2) When auto-scrutiny is selected and the data is fed accordingly, the system will register the case followed by the preparation of the list. If scrutiny by the FSO is selected, the application will be manually scrutinized following the existing process.

3) If offline payment is selected by the e-filer for any reason, manual scrutiny alone will be followed to maintain the integrity of the filing process.

4) The cause title is prepared by the system based on the data entered by the e-filer and will appear as the first page. The Statement of Facts will be from the next page onwards. (e-filers are not required to submit a separate cause title for the Statement of Facts. The system will automatically merge the cause title and the Statement of Facts).

5) In case any non-compliance with the Rules is detected in the Bench in respect of the auto scrutinized cases, the Court Officer shall have an option to mark such shortcomings and the cases can be routed to the dash board of the e filer for complying with the Rules/directions.In such cases, further scrutiny will be conducted by the Filing Scrutiny Officer. This process-flow will be available for the evaluation period, that is, till 01.08.2023 or till such other date as decided by the High Court.
